The following patients are not suitable for direct access endoscopy and should be referred for consultation

1. Patients over 70 years
2. Diabetic patients
3. Patients in whom active colitis is suspected
4. Patients on Warfarin
5. Patients with clotting disorders
6. Patients with sleep apnoea syndrome
7. Patients with significant cardio-respiratory disease or renal failure
8. Barium contrast study within the last 7 days

Please prescribe Kleanprep 4L for patients undergoing colonoscopy.
 Picolax should be avoided in patients with kidney disease and used with caution in the elderly.

Guidance

Patients on aspirin, persantin or clopidogrel should stop these medications 7 days prior to the procedure providing this is safe to do so.

Patients receiving proton pump inhibitors should stop these 7 days prior to the procedure

Patients should stop oral iron 7 days prior to colonoscopy
